

## GLAPHC Paint Promotion Program

All participants must be members in good standing and follow the requirements set forth in the GLAPHC Awards Requirements. This includes timely payment of membership dues, attendance at meetings (see Meeting Waiver Fee), and work a minimum of **six hours** at club activities (or make arrangement according to the Awards Requirements manner).

**ATTENTION: Awards are for horse/handler combinations.** All owners and competitors/handlers need to be members in good standing and complete all requirements to be eligible for year end awards. Trainers must be members and complete requirements (Owners may work their hours for them or pay the necessary fees). Juniors or riders who are participating with someone else's horse must be sure that they are members as well as the owner of the horse. **ALL REQUIREMENTS NEED TO BE MET.** Failure to comply will result in forfeit of any points earned. Questions can be directed to the Awards Chairman.

In the event that an owner is not planning on showing their own horse, they may transfer their requirements to the person that will be showing their horse. This is a one time per year transfer, and means that the owner would no longer be eligible to compete. Please call if you have any questions.

### Competition Point System

These points are multiplied by the number of entries in the class.

For example:

Rider places 3rd in a class of 10 the points for that class would be:

$$4 \text{ points} \times 10 \text{ (entries)} = 40 \text{ Points}$$

### REQUIREMENTS

- Membership with GLAPHC is required. Must be a member in good standing.
- Horse must be registered with APHA. Breeding Stock/Solid Paint Bred are encouraged to participate.
- Submit GLAPHC Paint Promotion Program Enrollment form to Awards Chairman
- Record time spent in the saddle. Riding alone or in a group is acceptable.
- Separate Log Sheets are required for each horse. Awards are for each Horse and Rider Combination.
- Mail in Log Sheet to GLAHC Awards Chairman in a timely manner.

## **GLAPHC Paint Promotion Awards**

The Greater Los Angeles Paint Horse Club would like to promote the Paint Horse in open activities and recognize those Paint Horses that are participating in Competitions and Trail Rides at local events. These include the following activities 4-H, ETI, Riding Club activities, team pennings, ropings, horse trials, Dressage, driving events, and other activities that fall outside the category of "APHA-approved show". These activities are similar to those stated by the APHA PAC (Paint Alternative Competition) program.

### **APPROVED ACTIVITIES**

Is open to any activity that is sponsored by an organization, that has a governing body, established record keeping, and an official who can sign the verification form. Other breed competitions are excluded.

### **ENROLLMENT**

- Membership with GLAPHC is required. Must be a member in good standing.
- The horse must be registered with APHA.  
Breeding Stock or Solid Bred Paint horses are encouraged to participate.
- **Sign up on the GLAPHC Paint Promotion Program enrollment form and send to Awards chairman.**

### **REPORTING**

- At completion of the activity, complete activity report.
- Present completed report form to secretary or manager for verification and signature.
- Mail report and a class list or equivalent to Awards Chairman **within 30 days** of the activity.

### **CATEGORIES**

The following activities are recognized by the Greater Los Angeles Paint Horse Club for the year 2013.

- Combined Training: Horse Trials and Combined Tests
- Cutting
- Dressage: All levels from introductory to Grand Prix, Freestyles included
- Driving: Pleasure Driving and Combined Driving

- English: Includes Pleasure, Hunter Under Saddle and Obedience
- Equitation: Includes Western and English Equitation and Equitation Over Fences
- Jumping: Included Hunter Hack, Hunters Over Fences, Jumpers

Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded for each category. Winners will be determined by the highest number of points earned in that category for the year. Year of competition is from January 1 to December 31 of the same year. Awards will be presented at the annual banquet.

## **Greater Los Angeles Paint Horse Club Rules and Requirements for Year End Awards**

The following are the rules and requirements for eligibility for Year End Awards as set forth by the Greater Los Angeles Paint Horse Club

The GLAPHC Paint Promotion Program for alternative activities or activities that are not APHA sponsored activities, with an award year from January 1, to December 31

- There will be an award for the top horses in each of the twenty categories (see GLAPHC Paint Promotion Awards Information sheet). Only GLAPHC members are eligible for these awards.
- The highest placing horse and rider/handler combination will be Champion and receive an award valued up to \$100\*.
- The second highest placing horse and rider/handler combination will be Reserve Champion and receive an award valued up to \$50\*.
- Awards will be presented at the awards Banquet or Club Meeting
- Member must complete and submit Paint Promotion Program Enrollment Form to Awards Chairman.
- Horse must be registered with APHA.
- **Send in completed performance report and a copy of class list or equivalent to Awards Chairman within 30 days of activity.**

### **ALL MEMBERS MUST COMPLETE THE FOLLOWING:**

- **Be a Member in Good Standing:**
  - 1) **Be current on all dues and fees.**
  - 2) **Attend at least 6 meetings between January and December of 2013** For those members that find attending meetings difficult either by distance, work or school, may apply for special hardship approval from the Horse Show Committee.
- **Work at least 6 hours (unpaid hours) at a club activity** with the award year. These activities may include any club sponsored horse show, trail ride, fund raiser or publicity activities\*\*.

**\*Winners must sign for award before it is ordered and must be picked up at the banquet or be signed for when picked up.**

**\*\*In the event you are unable to work your hours at any of the activities mentioned above, you may find a substitute to work on your behalf (These are unpaid hours). This change of worker needs to be reported to the Club President before the start of the club activity. These arrangements need to be made before the start of the activity..**
